## December 21, 2010 Meeting of the presidential evaluation committee *Minutes*

A meeting of the Presidential Evaluation Committee of the Board of Visitors of Virginia Commonwealth University was held on Thursday, December 21, 2010, at 9 a.m. in the Scott House Conference Room located at 909 West Franklin Street.
