November 10, 2010 **Meeting of the Audit and Compliance Committee** *Minutes*

A meeting of the Audit and Compliance Committee of the Board of Visitors of Virginia Commonwealth University was held on Wednesday, November 10, 2010, at 9:30 a.m. in the Richmond Salons located in the University Student Commons at 907 Floyd Avenue.

Committee members present were: Dr. Broaddus (Chair); Messrs. Ginther, Jones (via phone), McCandlish, Siegel and Snead; and Mrs. Rhodes. Dr. Shapiro was absent. Also present were Drs. Rao, Macrina, Retchin, Sarrett and Warren; Messrs. Anderson, Bennett, Bunce, Diehl, Jez, Litton, Napier, Ross, Skrocki and Willis; and Mesdames Atkinson, Balmer, Bishop, Currey, Lepley, Pousson and Taylor.

Dr. Broaddus called the meeting to order and on motion made and seconded, the Committee approved the Minutes of a Meeting held on August 25, 2010.

The Proposed Audit Plan for January 1 – June 30, 2011 was presented and discussed. On motion made and seconded, the Audit and Compliance Committee recommended to the full Board the approval of the Proposed Audit Plan for January 1- June 30, 2011.

The Proposed 2011 University Compliance Work Plan for January 1 through June 30, 2011 and the Conflict of Interest - University Policies and Practices were presented for information.

On motion made and seconded, the Committee convened into closed session to discuss certain personnel matters involving the performance of identifiable employees or faculty of VCU, and to discuss the evaluation of performance of departments or schools of VCU where such evaluation will necessarily involve discussion of the performance of specific individuals, including Audit Reports of individually identified departments and/or schools, and to consult with legal counsel and receive briefings by staff members regarding legal matters and actual or probable litigation relating to the aforementioned Audit Reports where such consultation or briefing in open session would adversely affect the negotiating or litigating posture of VCU, as may be necessary, as authorized by Section 2.2-3711 A(1) and A(7) of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act.

Following closed session, on motion made and seconded, the following resolution was approved by roll call vote:

The Audit and Compliance Committee of the Board of Visitors of Virginia Commonwealth University hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements by Virginia law were discussed in the closed session meeting to which this certification resolution applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed session meeting were heard, discussed or considered by the Audit and Compliance Committee of the Board of Visitors of Virginia Commonwealth University.
